

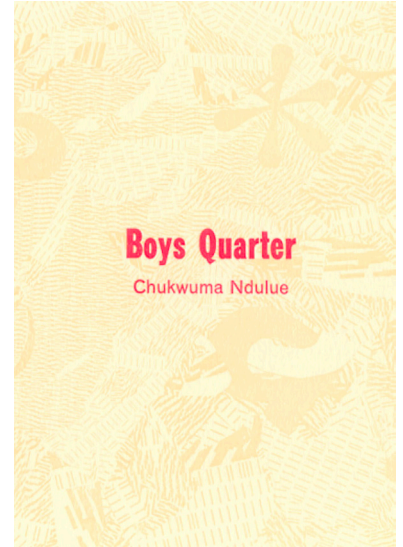
Chukwuma Ndulue
